

Our Forest School Ground Rules!



We listen to each other

We always listen to what others have to say. We listen with our ears, our eyes, our heads and our hearts.

Swing low sweet hammock

One person in the hammock at a time and no 360s! We push our friends gently.

Two arms and a tool

We always use tools the safe way, making sure that we are sitting down and are two arms and a tool's length away from anybody else.

Fire circle

We call "Red Dragons!" to remind anyone who might not be moving safely around the fire circle and use "Green Dragons" when we are near the fire circle safely.

When we are practising fire-lighting, we choose our spot carefully, always use 'safe kneeling' and make sure hair and clothing are out of the way.

What's brown and sticky?

A stick!

We carry sticks pointing down to the ground. If they are longer than our arm, we drag them or find a friend to hold the other end.

Boundaries

We have *physical boundaries*: we know where we are allowed to play and explore; and we have *emotional boundaries*: we respect ourselves, each other and our environment.

Whistle

3 whistles means return immediately to the fire-circle (it could be the end of the session, or there might be an emergency). 1 whistle means tool swap.
